INTRODUCTION

The Foothill – De Anza Community College ("District") is pleased to submit its 10th Utilization Report for the District's portion of the former Onizuka Air Force Station referenced below. This report covers the one year period from February 14, 2023 through February 13, 2024.

I. GRANTEE

The Grantee is the Foothill – De Anza Community College District located at: 12345 El Monte Road
Los Altos Hills. California 94022

II. PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION

The property is described as Parcel C of the former Onizuka Air Force Station in Sunnyvale, California. The Foothill College Center ("Center") is now located on the site. Construction on the Center was started in late 2014 and completed in early 2016.



III. PROGRAM OF UTILIZATION

Course offerings and Attendance Data are included in Attachments 3-1.

Currently, there are no outside organizations using the Center. In past years, the California Virtual Campus – Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI) was at the Center as part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), between FHDA and CVC-OEI. The MOU expired on June 30, 2021.

There was another MOU between the District and West Valley-Mission Community College. This MOU has expired as of June 30, 2018.

Should either of these organizations wish to return, or any other organization interested in utilizing spaces within the Center, we will notify the U.S Department of Education to formally request approval, before any agreements are in place.

Non-Educational Site Use: As of this report date, there are no spaces for use for non-educational purposes after the first day of instruction.

IV. STATUS OF PROPERTY

Construction on the Center was substantially completed on August 31, 2016, and instruction has been continuous with the exception of the pandemic restrictions between March 17, 2020 through February 28, 2022 when the County Health Officer rescinded the order of indoor masking. Foothill College has struggled to maintain its enrollment including enrollment at the Center since the pandemic. The Emergency Medical Services program (EMT and Paramedic) however, has consistently remained at the Center since its opening in 2016 and its enrollment has remained steady.

For the 2023-2024 school year, there is good news. Enrollment has increased in the Emergency Medical Services program from 114 students in 2022-2023 school year, to 143 students in 2023-2024 school year, a 20% increase. Furthermore, enrollment in English as a Second Language (ESL) course has also increased 25% yearly. The College is hopeful that this trend will continue.

In April 2023, a letter was emailed to the U.S. Department of Education (Attachment 4-1), regarding the District's plans to substantially renovate the Center and move the Radiologic Technology, Respiratory Therapy and Pharmacy Technology programs from the main Foothill College campus in Los Altos Hills, to the Center. Due to budget concerns, the Pharmacy Technology will remain at the main Foothill campus for now.

Subsequent correspondence to Ms. Yolanda Stroud regarding the renovation project at the Center, and additional information (Attachments 4-2 to 4-6) is included in this report as well as a cost estimate. The design team is getting ready to submit the full set of drawings and specifications to the Division of the State Architects' (DSA) office in February 2024. DSA is the authority having jurisdiction over the District's construction projects. The cost estimate, included herein is based on the latest data we have on materials and labor rates in our area. Once we have prepared a more up to date cost estimate, which I anticipate to be prior to bidding on the project, I will be providing it to the US Dept of Education.











VI. ENCUMBRANCES AND PROPERTY USE ARRANGEMENTS

Non-Procurement Debarment and Suspension: Foothill College and our authorized representative are not currently listed in the System for Award Management (SAM.gov) as being debarred or suspended from receiving non-financial assistance from the Federal Government.

Property Use Clarification: The District requested confirmation from the Department of Education that some uses of the parcel that include charging fees will not violate limitations in the property's deed. The District would like to inform the U.S. Department of Education of its planned renovations of the Foothill Sunnyvale Center. It has been 7 years since the completion of the building built on Parcel C of the former Onizuka Air Force Station in Sunnyvale, CA. Since it's opening, a majority of the classes taught on the premises were general education with a few specialized courses from Allied Health. The District has continued to teach general education courses. Unfortunately, enrollment has steadily declined, and with the arrival of the pandemic, enrollment has not yet recovered.

Foothill College is shifting its enrollment focus at the Sunnyvale Center by exploring the possibility of moving three programs from the main Foothill campus in Los Altos Hills, to the Sunnyvale Center. These programs are: Respiratory Therapy, Radiologic Technology, and Pharmacy Technology. The Emergency Medical Services program(EMT & Paramedic) has always been a presence at the facility and will continue to remain there.

In November 2022, the District hired tBP Architects from Walnut Creek to initially do a Programming and Feasibility exercise to determine the effort required to renovate and eventually move these three programs to the facility, and to provide a budgetary number to see if the "move" is financially feasible.

The architects met with the stakeholders of Respiratory Therapy, Radiologic Technology, and Pharmacy Technology, and even visited similar facilities in the area. We are currently waiting for their report and the information in that report will determine whether it is possible to proceed.

Once the report is finalized, I will provide updated information to the U. S. Department of Education. The Foothill College will not proceed until the U.S. Department of Education has been made fully aware of the scope and the District has received it's approval.

Please call or email if you have any further questions. In the meantime, I look forward to providing you periodic updates of this process.

It was a please talking with you yesterday regarding the future renovation plans of Foothill College for the Sunnyvale Center, located at Parcel C of the former Ozinuka Air Force Station. The formal address is at 1070 Innovation Way, Sunnyvale, CA 94089.

When the Center opened in 2016, the Center was providing General Education Courses as well as courses from the Emergency Medical Services program (EMT and Paramedic). Enrollment for general education courses was steady after the first few years but was slowly declining thereafter. The pandemic hit and Foothill College has struggled to keep enrollment up at the Center. The enrollment for EMT and Paramedic courses have remained steady and have been in the Center, even during the pandemic.

To revitalize the Center, Foothill College is exploring the possibility of moving three programs that are currently located at the main Foothill College campus in Los Altos Hills. These programs are Radiologic Technology, Respiratory Therapy and Pharmacy Technology. The current space they occupy at the main campus is needing some upgrading so rather than upgrade their existing space, it makes more sense to move the programs to the Center to revitalize it. The spaces that these programs will be vacating will be renovated so that the Dental Hygiene program can expand to the spaces vacated by the three programs.

Foothill College has hired tBP Architects to do a feasibility study and cost analysis to move these programs to the Center. As part of the study and cost analysis, the Center will also upgrade the existing HVAC system. We are waiting for the report from tBP Architects and once the report is finished, the District will use the report to help in the decision making process.

If Foothill College decides that the moving these programs to the Center is feasible, we will notify the U.S. Department of Education of the College's plans and formally seek approval.

Below are our responses to your questions:

1) Please clarify financials for the changes?

We have currently completed the schematic design for the project and the engineer's preliminary estimate for the project is \$18,865,306. This will be funded by multiple sources of funding including local bond funds:

 Measure C \$5,680,597

 Measure G \$8,000,000

 Capital Funds from Foothill College \$2,700,000

 State Funds
 \$484,709

 Federal Funds(HEERF)
 \$2,000,000

Measure G is a local bond that the District passed in 2020, and is an \$890 Mil bond. Should additional funds be needed to pay for this project, we have a

contingency line item from the Measure G which would backfill the shortfall. To reiterate, this is a preliminary engineers estimate based on Schematic Design.

We will not have firm estimate until we have completed the preparation of Construction Drawings, which we anticipate to be in January 2024.

The scope of this project is to replace the existing mechanical unit, renovate a majority of the classrooms to house Respiratory Technology and

Radiologic Technology, purchase of associated equipment related to the two programs, minor ADA upgrades, renovation of administrative spaces, and the addition of one electric vehicle charging station. The District's Emergency Medical Response (EMR)/Emergency Medical Transport (EMT) and the Paramedic Program are existing programs that are already at the Sunnyvale Center.

2) Increase Enrollment?

The numbers below are projected numbers of enrollment, and the building will be fully occupied with capacity to have additional classes when needed.

Good Afternoon and Happy New Year Ms. Stroud:

We are preparing the yearly Space Utilization Report for the Parcel C of the former Onizuka Air Force Station Sunnyvale, California, which is now the site of the Foothill College Sunnyvale Center. We should have that report ready by February 2024.

In my email dated July 28, 2023, I mentioned that the Foothill De Anza Community College District are in the planning stages for renovating the building to move some programs from the main Foothill campus to the Sunnyvale Center. Updates and full scope description are below:

The HVAC System Replacement and Classroom Renovation Project for Foothill College's Sunnyvale Education Center includes fully renovating the HVAC system and the majority of classrooms to support several allied health programs. The improvements will support the development of health professionals who use scientific principles and evidence-based practice for the diagnosis, evaluation and treatment of acute and chronic diseases; promote disease prevention and wellness for optimum health, and apply administration and management skills to support health care systems in a variety of settings.

The Sunnyvale Center's HVAC system has been poorly functioning for many years despite multiple, sustained repair efforts. In 2021 the college hired a third party engineering firm to provide a detailed HVAC system study, and the firm recommended replacing the system with an all-electric, efficient and more conventional four-pipe heating and cooling system. The design includes installing a new heat pump and chiller on the roof along with individual fan coil units for each classroom to provide 100% outside air, adds MERV 13 filters for air filtration, and provides individual control for heating and cooling in each classroom.

The college has several existing allied programs that will benefit by being clustered together at the Sunnyvale campus including Radiological Technology, Respiratory Therapy and the Paramedic / EMT programs. About 10,700 of the 46,000 square foot building will be remodeled to accommodate the modern labs, technology and an extensive array of program equipment.

We anticipate submitting the architectural plans to the Division of the State Architect in February, 2024 and we expect to procure a contractor in the Winter. The total project costs are estimated at \$18.9M, including \$15M in construction (including contingency), \$2.2M in specialized equipment, and \$1.7M in soft costs.

Dear Ms. Shawyer:

The deed to the Onizuka parcel transferred to the Foothill-De Anza Community College District, now the site of our new education center, limits the use of the property solely to educational purposes. Article 6 of the deed does not allow the District to lease, sublease, or rent the facility without obtaining advance written consent, and requires the District to remain a tax-supported or non-profit institution. It is not the District's intention to vary from these requirements, but some of our programs do involve charging fees for facility use or educational programs. We do not want to run afoul of the deed's requirements, so we would like your concurrence that normal, ongoing operations fall within the deed restrictions.

The District is a publicly funded educational institution. Like all California Community Colleges, we offer a full array of classes for credit, non-credit classes, classes offered for continuing education, contract education and community education. Revenue from these educational programs is used to offset costs of offering the programs. We intend to offer all of these educational courses at the new education center, starting the fall quarter, 2016.

To best serve our students, we have included in our new building a small café and bookstore to allow our students to purchase the supplies they need, as well as coffee and snacks on site. The facility is operated by the District, not a contracted entity, and we anticipate this operation to be self - sustaining and not generate any measurable profit.

The District has agreements with a bank to provide ATM machines for students and staff inside campus buildings, and we are planning to offer that service at the education center.

California Community Colleges are permitted to rent college facilities to members of the public under rates approved by our local Boards of Trustees. At both District campuses, Foothill College and De Anza College, we regularly rent instructional space, gymnasiums, swimming pool, theater, and similar facilities. These rental fees and associated direct costs are not profit

generating and are used to maintain and repair rented facilities to ensure that our students and community can enjoy facilities that are safe and well maintained within constraints of our funding. We are planning to charge appropriate fees for use of spaces at the Education Center, as approved by the Board of Trustees. Attached is the current Foothill College Facility Rental Rates list as an example; a similar list for the new facility will be sent to the Board for approval.

We would like to ensure that the Department of Education approves of these activities. If you have any concerns or questions, please don't hesitate to contact me.

Public Content

Background and Analysis:

The attached Sanitary Sewer Easement Deed between Foothill-De Anza Community College District and the City of Sunnyvale was previously submitted to the Board of Trustees on August 31, 2015, and was approved by the Board. It added a 5-foot Sanitary Sewer Easement adjacent to the then existing 10-foot Easement that crossed the Education Center site. That additional Easement was approved by the Board and was recorded on September 18, 2015, with the Santa Clara County Clerk Recorder's office as document #23084650.

History:

An existing ten-foot wide Sanitary Sewer Easement had crossed the Education Center site when the District took ownership of the site. The City of Sunnyvale had requested that the Easement width be increased to conform to City standards. It was in the District's best interest to increase the Easement width to allow future replacement or maintenance of the sanitary sewer line, and that width was accommodated in the project design. The dedication of the additional 5-foot wide easement adjacent to the existing 10-foot wide easement provided a 15-foot wide access corridor requested by the City for a new sanitary sewer. The Education Center site was constructed along with the new Sanitary Sewer across the site by Contractors working for the District.

Analysis:

The 15-foot Sanitary Sewer Easement required minor adjustments to show the exact location of the installed Sanitary Sewer as it crossed the Education Center site. This revised Sanitary Sewer Easement shows the exact location of the sewer and adjusts the Easement to align with the installed sewer location. With the Board's approval and recording of this new Easement at the Santa Clara County Recorder's Office, the City of Sunnyvale will accept the revised Easement and have the existing two Easements vacated.

Education Code Section 81310 authorizes the Board of Trustees to dedicate such an easement to a public utility.





RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE TO ACCEPT ALL DEEDS AND GRANTS CONVEYING ANY INTEREST IN OR EASEMENT UPON REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE AND TO CONSENT TO THEIR RECORDATION AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 200-76

WHEREAS, Section 27281 of the Government Code of the State of California provides that deeds or grants conveying any interest in or easement upon real estate to a political corporation or governmental agency for public purposes shall not be acceptable for recordation without the consent of the grantee evidenced by the resolution of acceptance attached to said deed or grant deed; and

SECTION 1. The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to accept, for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyvale, all deeds and grants conveying any interest in or easement upon real estate to the City of Sunnyvale, and to consent to their recordation.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to certify to the adoption of this resolution and to attach a copy thereof to each such deed or grant presented for recordation.

SECTION 3. Resolution No. 200-76 is hereby rescinded.
